Jalgaon District Maratha Vidya Prasarak Cooperative Samaj Ltd. Jalgaon established its first college of Arts, Commerce and Science College at Jalgaon in the year 1972. In due course of time with guidance of visionaries of Society and with efforts of well qualified teachers the college has grown with addition of new divisions and new courses and has expanded in its scope and gained a reputation in the entire Jalgaon district and being identified as Nutan Maratha College. In due course of time there were some visionaries who gave massive financial support for building its infrastructural resources in the form of donation, therefore their names are given to various faculties.

The registered name of this college has become Shri S. S. Patil Arts, Shri Bhausaheb T.T. Salunkhe Commerce and Shri G.R. Pandit Science College, Jalgaon This college is affiliated to KBC North Maharashtra University and the college caters the education from 11th Std to M. A., M. Com, M.Sc. students. The college runs graduate courses in Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Microbiology, Zoology, Mathematics, Computer Science, Electronic etc. Graduation and Post-Graduation in Languages English, Hindi, Marathi, Urdu and in all social sciences are available along with separate commerce faculty. The college has well qualified teaching staff to cater all of its courses and most of the teachers are also guiding M. Phil. and Ph. D. Students.

The college is situated in the heart of the city with 08 acres of land & has a built up area of 8584 square meters. The college has thirty-five class rooms, Science, computer science, Psychology, English language laboratories, Geography, Commerce Social Sciences departments, Gymkhana, partially automated central library, NSS, NCC, NAAC, IQAC offices, Principal, vice principal, administrative offices, gents and ladies staff rooms and ladies' room for girls. In addition to these the audio-visual aids, OHP, LCDs, power generator, invertors, safe and purified drinking water, vehicle parking for students and the teachers as well, playground, facilities for indoor and outdoor games etc.

1. CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS:

It is obligatory upon students of the college to follow this Code of Conduct. The college wants to enforce this Code of Conduct for maintaining discipline among the students which promotes student growth through individual and collective responsibility. All Students are requested to follow this Code of Conduct.

DISCIPLINE:

All the students must follow the disciplinary rules and regulations set down by the college from time to time. Cases of indiscipline will be dealt with as per these rules and regulations. Students are advised to follow the academic calendar as per the instructions of the principal. Students shall refrain from damaging college property as it can be followed by compensation for the damage caused. Students shall only use the dustbins for disposing waste materials in the campus to keep the campus clean. It is mandatory for students to park their vehicles in parking zone only. Students must refrain from indulging in anti-institutional, anti-national, antisocial and political activities within the campus and hostel. Students shall note that cases of ragging and harassment will be dealt with as per the UGC regulations and Indian Penal Code. Educational tours shall be accompanied by the faculty members with the written consent of the concerned authority and only after taking necessary undertaking from the Parents or Guardian of the students. Outsiders into the college campus and hostel are strictly prohibited. Students shall not bring outsiders to the campus and hostel without the permission of the authorities. Cases of criminal activity or violation of law and order in the college campus will be followed by strict actions and will be reported to the police if required.

Identity Card

Students must carry college identity card all the times in the campus, particularly during lectures and examinations. They should produce the same as and when demanded by the authorities. Identity Card will be issued as per the given schedule after the confirmation of admission. The students should collect their identity card from the library and can make use of the same for lending books from the library. The loss of the identity card should be reported immediately to the librarian with an application.

HUMAN VALUES

Honesty is demanded in all the academic activities and with all the stakeholders of the college. Be attentive, cooperative and fair towards your teachers and peers all the time. Practise empathy for your fellow citizens and care towards your surroundings.

MOBILE PHONE & ELECTRONIC DEVICES

The student should keep their mobile phones switched off in the classroom, laboratory, library and whenever and wherever required. Mobile phones, electronic devices like smart watches are strictly prohibited during the examination in the college campus. The college will not be responsible for loss or theft of any valuables of the students.

ATTENDANCE

Students are required to be regular in the classes. They must maintain at least 75% attendance in the lectures of all the subjects obtained by them. Disciplinary actions will be taken against the student if found irregular in the lectures. Absence from college due to medical reasons

should be followed by submission of medical certificate immediately at the time of joining. The students coming late for lectures will not be allowed to enter the class. Attendance in internal and external examinations is compulsory. Similarly, attendance in practicals and seminars organized by the college is compulsory. The student will be entirely responsible for such absence.

SOCIAL MEDIA USE

Students are expected to handle social media with complete care. They must not post any insulting comment about any individual or indulge in any such related activities on social media which may harm the reputation of the college.

ANTI-RAGGING

Strict actions will be taken against the students indulging in ragging as per the regulations set down by the University Grants Commission. Ragging is legally banned and is a punishable offence. All students and their parents / guardians must sign the anti-ragging affidavit. The students are advised to contact the Anti-Ragging Committee in case of emergency.

The Anti-Ragging Committee may take the following actions against those found guilty of ragging

- i) Suspension from attending classes and other academic activities.
- ii) Withholding / withdrawing scholarship and fellowship.
- iii) Debarring from appearing in any examination.
- iv) Expulsion from the hostel.
- v) Cancellation of admission.
- vi) Rustication from the institution for a period ranging from one to four semesters.
- vii) Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period.

EXAMINATIONS

The students must strictly follow the rules and regulations of examination set down by Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University Jalgaon.

GIRLS HOSTEL

The rules concerning admission and conduct in college hostel for girls are to be strictly followed. Violation of these rules may result in fines and expulsion from the hostel, including debarring from readmission to the hostel.
