Objectives-

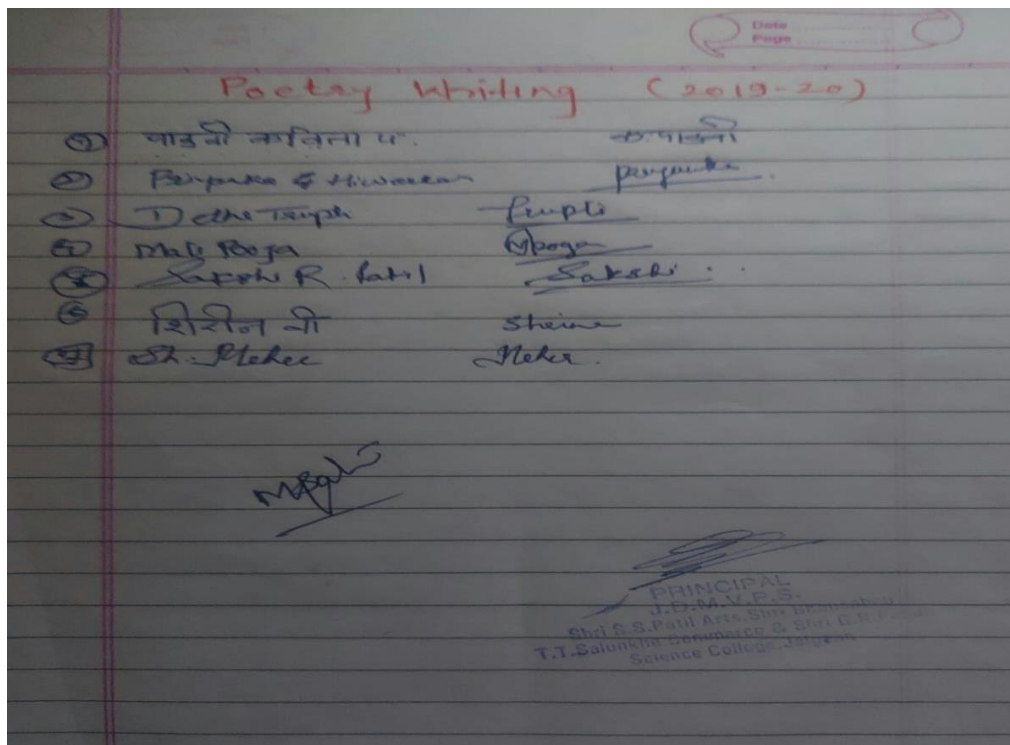
- 1 To provide a platform for students to express their feelings in the form of poetry.

- 5 Verbal and non verbal communication abilities increases, active listening, and expressing ideas effectively.





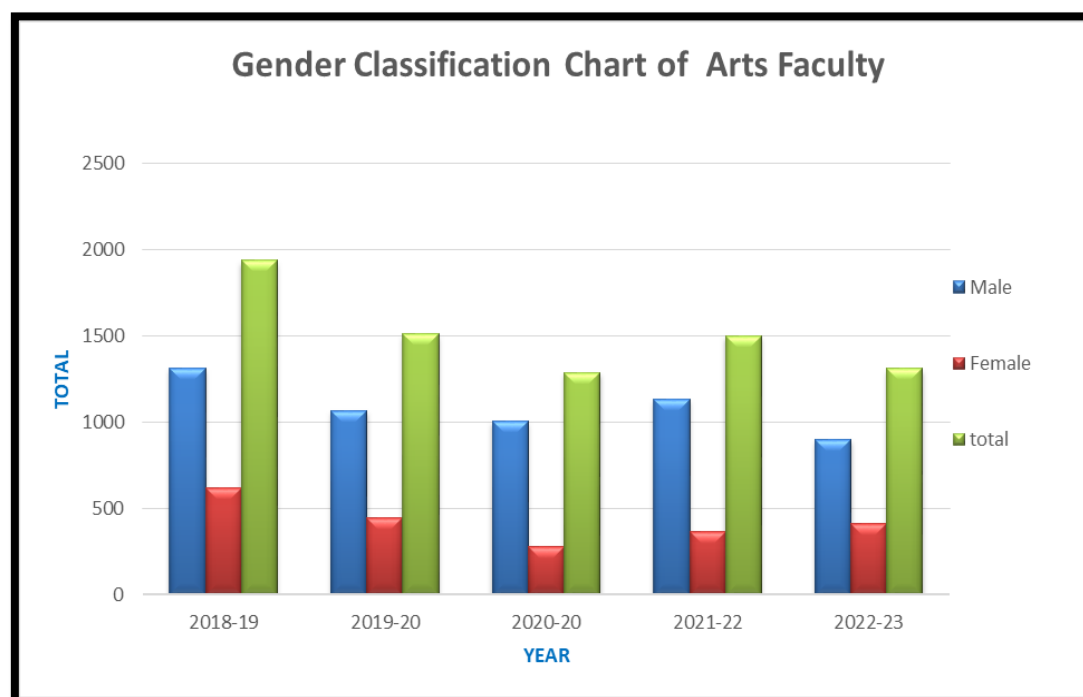

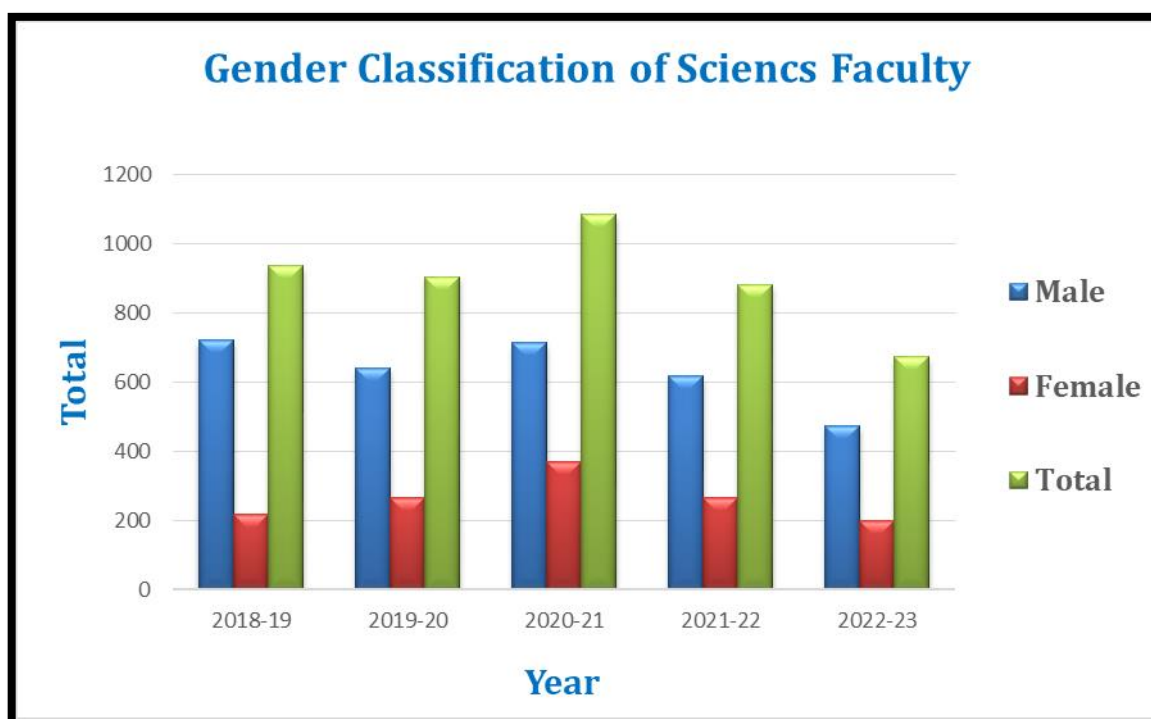

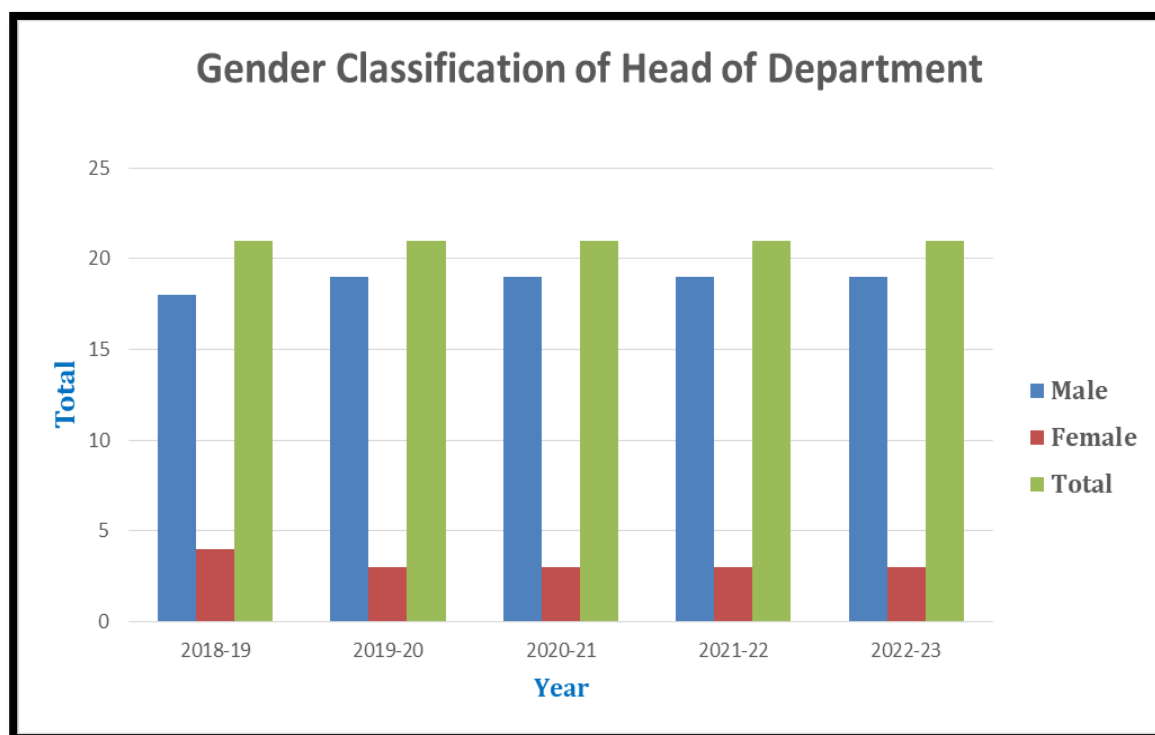

- We will start Women Study Centre to research in Gender balance equality.
- To avoid inequality care we should take to appoint balanced number of conveners of various internal committees of the college.

CONCLUSION

It found that the Jalgaon District Maratha Vidya Prasarak Samaj's Shri. S. S. Patil Arts, Shri. Bhausahab T. T. Salunkhe Commerce and Shri. G. R. Pandit Science College Jalgaon has many strengths. The weaknesses to overcome with efficient mind set, doubtless, its strengths contribute towards making the college as a gender sensitive institution. With the strong will power and commitment to gender justice, the college would certainly make a mark even in the areas that need some improvements.
