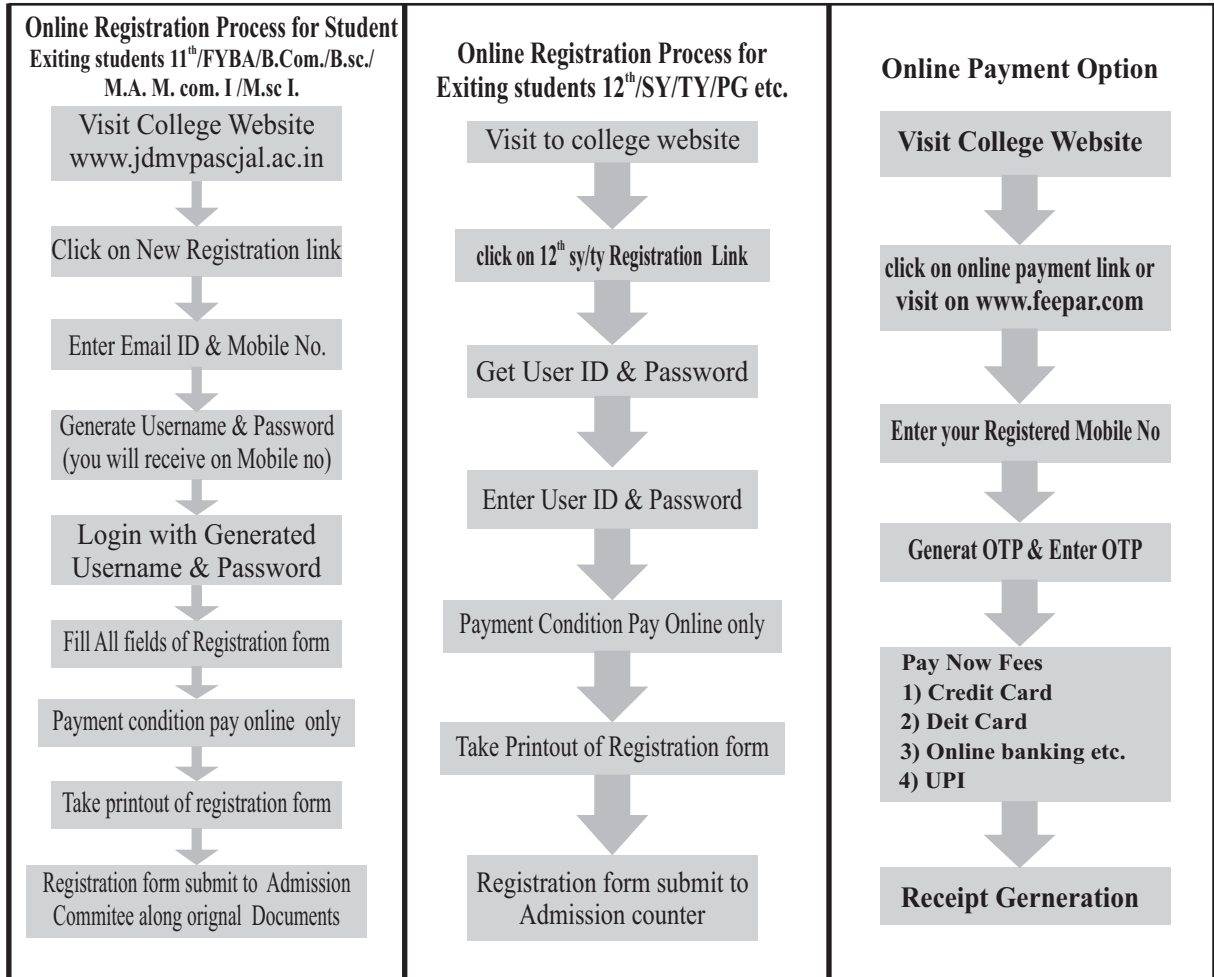

For Paying fee students:

- 10% of the total fees within seven days
- No refund after seven days of admission.
- In case of cancellation of the admission before the granting of the scholarship, the student is liable to pay the whole fees.
- Any non granted admission fee will not be refundable

The depository fees will be refunded after filling up



the form with the acknowledgement slip within two years, otherwise the same will be collected in college fund.

12) Identity Card:

The Identity card is compulsory for each student in the college campus.

The students can collect Identity Card after the producing the fee acknowledgement slip to the librarian in the library after completion of college admission process. The supported documents are as follows:

- i. Library Reader / Identity Card Form.
 - ii. Two recent passport size photographs.
- The delay in collection of Identity Card more than one month will be punishable as per office authority.
 - The Identity Card should be produced by the student wherever demanded by the teaching / Non-Teaching staff of the college.
 - No Individual change is acceptable on the Identity Card.
 - In case of missing of the Identity Card, the new identity Card is chargeable with extra Rupees 50/-.

13. Disciplinary Rules for Students:

- The Student must read the “Notice” regularly displayed on the College Notice Board.
- Keeping of Identity Card is obligatory.
- The student must remain present for the lectures regularly.
- Note the changes in the syllabus time to time, in case of re-admission.
- Obey the rules framed by the college authorities regarding the general behavior and studies.
- The student should remain present for college and university examinations.

- In case of emergency, the student should grant the permission from the concerned Vice-Principal.
- The third party (for non-academic purpose) is not allowed with students in the campus.
- Take care of the name and fame of the college. Any tampering with the furniture, electronic parts, laboratory, and library books etc. is a punishable offence.
- Smoking of cigarettes, consumption of Gutka, Tobacco etc. is strictly prohibited in college campus.
- Keeping and Using of Mobile phones are restricted.
- The clean and formal clothing is expected from the students.
- Park the bicycles, motor bikes in the parking.
- The student should abide by the rules and other instructions.
- Ragging (Direct or Indirect) in the campus is a criminal offence and it will be result in a punishment.

Code of Conduct for Reading Room

- Identity Card is Mandatory.

- The books should be referred in the reading room only. If it is found outside the reading room, the student will be charged the fine of Rupees 100/- and will be restricted from using reading room in later course.

Department of Higher Secondary Education

Admission should be taken as per schedule decided by government of Maharashtra school education and sports department in class XI and in class XII. By attaching the application form and documents. The information requested in the online admission should be complete and accurate, the information about the fee is given separately on college website.

Students from Boards other than S.S.C. Boards in the state Maharashtra are required a temporary certificate from the Nashik Board's office before admission. Admission of these students may be revoked at any time till final eligibility certificate is obtained.

Attested copy of documents attached with application Students should be kept (certificates, mark sheet, leaving certificate etc.)

Every student may get admission in N.C.C. or physical Education. The subjects selected in class XI have to be taken in class XII. Once the subject is selected, it cannot be changed. such permission will be granted only after the Department of Education orders permission to change it.

The following documents should be attached with the application for admission in class XI.

- 1) Attested copy of 10th mark sheet (xerox)
- 2) 10th original certificate (L.C) and two copies of it.
- 3) Attested copy of caste certificates.
- 4) Attested copy of Aadhar card.
- 5) Two passport photos.

The following documents should be attached with application for admission in class XII.

- 1) Attested copy of 10th mark sheet.
- 2) Attested copy of 11th mark sheet.
- 3) Attested copy of 10th Leaving certificate (L.C.)
- 4) Attested copy of Aadhar card.
- 5) 11th original certificate (L.C.) and a copy of it (passed 11th class from other Junior college)

Admission approval should be obtained by checking the admission application from the office. After that the admission process should be completed by taking the fee challan.

Students who have passed XIth Higher secondary vocation course will not get a admission in class XII Arts, commerce, science they will get admission only in XIIth vocational course. If the challan fee has been paid online before admission, then it is wrong to assume that admission has taken place.

Department of Higher Secondary Education

- If you get 70 marks out of 200 marks for each Subject in this year, you can pass that subject.
 - It is necessary to pass every subject in class XI. A total of 600 marks are taken in six subjects, also for XII class, a total of 600 marks are taken as project, Seminars and reports on environment education.
 - Environment education and Health and physical Education are compulsory subject examined as grade of that subject is given for class XI and XII
 - Other concession for - E.B.C. / P.T.C / F.F.T. / S.C. / N.T. / S.T. / Freeship / Staff member
 - Laboratory fees will be charged separately for non-granted subjects.
 - Paying- All Students Paying fees
- 4) Admission to the first year of B.A./B.com/ B.Sc/ E- commerce/B.B.S./L.L.B/ B.S.W.
- 5) Direct admission to the second year of polytechnic for students who have passed class XII in vocational course

Students enrolled in higher secondary vocational courses are taught in class XI and XII English, Marathi and General foundation course. these three subjects are compulsory for all vocational courses and three subjects of any one of the following vocational courses should be taken. A total of seven subject marks should be taken (650)

H.S.C. Vocational Course

In recent times, it has become imperative to complete technical and vocational courses to get employment, with this requirement government approved vocational courses are available in the College. class XI and class XII is a two year course and at the same time only 20 students are admitted in the course. Maharashtra state Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education conducts class XII examination of this vocational course.

The following opportunities are available to the students after completing the vocational course.

- 1) There are many opportunities for employment and self employment.
- 2) Apprenticeship can be done after completion of the course.
- 3) Apprenticeship opportunities at Jalgaon Janata Bank and Jalgaon People's Bank.
